

Verses about Satan:

I Chronicles 21:1: And **Satan** stood up against Israel, and provoked David to number Israel.

Job 1:6:

Now there was a day when the sons of God came to present themselves before the LORD, and **Satan** came also among them.

Job 1:7: And the LORD said unto **Satan**, Whence comest thou? Then **Satan** answered the LORD, and said, From going to and fro in the earth, and from walking up and down in it.

Job 1:8: And the LORD said unto **Satan**, Hast thou considered my servant Job, that there is none like him in the earth, a perfect and an upright man, one that feareth God, and escheweth evil?

Job 1:9: Then **Satan** answered the LORD, and said, Doth Job fear God for nought?

Job 1:12: And the LORD said unto **Satan**, Behold, all that he hath is in thy power; only upon himself put not forth thine hand. So **Satan** went forth from the presence of the LORD.

Job 2:1: Again there was a day when the sons of God came to present themselves before the LORD, and **Satan** came also among them to present himself before the LORD.

Job 2:2: And the LORD said unto **Satan**, From whence comest thou? And **Satan** answered the LORD, and said, From going to and fro in the earth, and from walking up and down in it.

Job 2:3: And the LORD said unto **Satan**, Hast thou considered my servant Job, that there is none like him in the earth, a perfect and an upright man, one that feareth God, and escheweth evil? and still he holdeth fast his integrity, although thou movedst me against him, to destroy him without cause.

Job 2:4: And **Satan** answered the LORD, and said, Skin for skin, yea, all that a man hath will he give for his life.

Job 2:6: And the LORD said unto **Satan**, Behold, he is in thine hand; but save his life.

Job 2:7:

So went **Satan** forth from the presence of the LORD, and smote Job with sore boils from the sole of his foot unto his crown.

Psalms 109:6:

Set thou a wicked man over him: and let **Satan** stand at his right hand.

Zechariah 3:1: And he shewed me Joshua the high priest standing before the angel of the LORD, and **Satan** standing at his right hand to resist him.

Zechariah 3:2: And the LORD said unto **Satan**, The LORD rebuke thee, O **Satan**; even the LORD that hath chosen Jerusalem rebuke thee: is not this a brand plucked out of the fire?

Matthew 4:10: Then saith Jesus unto him, Get thee hence, **Satan**: for it is written, Thou shalt worship the Lord thy God, and him only shalt thou serve.

Matthew 12:26: And if **Satan** cast out **Satan**, he is divided against himself; how shall then his kingdom stand?

Matthew 16:23: But he turned, and said unto Peter, Get thee behind me, **Satan**: thou art an offence unto me: for thou savourest not the things that be of God, but those that be of men.

Mark 1:13: And he was there in the wilderness forty days, tempted of **Satan**; and was with the wild beasts; and the angels ministered unto him.

Mark 3:23: And he called them unto him, and said unto them in parables, How can **Satan** cast out **Satan**?

Mark 3:26: And if **Satan** rise up against himself, and be divided, he cannot stand, but hath an end.

Mark 4:15: And these are they by the way side, where the word is sown; but when they have heard, **Satan** cometh immediately, and taketh away the word that was sown in their hearts.

Mark 8:33: But when he had turned about and looked on his disciples, he rebuked Peter, saying, Get thee behind me, **Satan**: for thou savourest not the things that be of God, but the things that be of men.

Luke 4:8: And Jesus answered and said unto him, Get thee behind

me, **Satan**: for it is written, Thou shalt worship the Lord thy God, and him only shalt thou serve.

Luke 10:18: And he said unto them, I beheld **Satan** as lightning fall from heaven.

Luke 11:18: If **Satan** also be divided against himself, how shall his kingdom stand? because ye say that I cast out devils through Beelzebub.

Luke 13:16: And ought not this woman, being a daughter of Abraham, whom **Satan** hath bound, lo, these eighteen years, be loosed from this bond on the sabbath day?

Luke 22:3:
Then entered **Satan** into Judas surnamed Iscariot, being of the number of the twelve.

Luke 22:31:
And the Lord said, Simon, Simon, behold, **Satan** hath desired to have you, that he may sift you as wheat:

John 13:27: And after the sop **Satan** entered into him. Then said Jesus unto him, That thou doest, do quickly.

Acts 5:3: But Peter said, Ananias, why hath **Satan** filled thine heart to lie to the Holy Ghost, and to keep back part of the price of the land?

Acts 26:18: To open their eyes, and to turn them from darkness to light, and from the power of **Satan** unto God, that they may receive forgiveness of sins, and inheritance among them which are sanctified by faith that is in me.

Romans 16:20: And the God of peace shall bruise **Satan** under your feet shortly. The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ be with you. Amen.

I Corinthians 5:5: To deliver such an one unto **Satan** for the destruction of the flesh, that the spirit may be saved in the day of the Lord Jesus.

I Corinthians 7:5: Defraud ye not one the other, except it be with consent for a time, that ye may give yourselves to fasting and prayer; and come together again, that **Satan** tempt you not for your incontinency.

II Corinthians 2:11: Lest **Satan** should get an advantage of us: for we are not ignorant of his devices.

II Corinthians 11:14: And no marvel; for **Satan** himself is transformed into an angel of light.

II Corinthians 12:7: And lest I should be exalted above measure through the abundance of the revelations, there was given to me a thorn in the flesh, the messenger of **Satan** to buffet me, lest I should be exalted above measure.

I Thessalonians 2:18: Wherefore we would have come unto you, even I Paul, once and again; but **Satan** hindered us.

II Thessalonians 2:9: Even him, whose coming is after the working of **Satan** with all power and signs and lying wonders,

I Timothy 1:20: Of whom is Hymenaeus and Alexander; whom I have delivered unto **Satan**, that they may learn not to blaspheme.

I Timothy 5:15: For some are already turned aside after **Satan**.

Revelation of John 2:9: I know thy works, and tribulation, and poverty, (but thou art rich) and I know the blasphemy of them which say they are Jews, and are not, but are the synagogue of **Satan**.

Revelation of John 2:13: I know thy works, and where thou dwellest, even where **Satan**'s seat is: and thou holdest fast my name, and hast not denied my faith, even in those days wherein Antipas was my faithful martyr, who was slain among you, where **Satan** dwelleth.

Revelation of John 2:24: But unto you I say, and unto the rest in Thyatira, as many as have not this doctrine, and which have not known the depths of **Satan**, as they speak; I will put upon you none

other burden.

Revelation of John 3:9: Behold, I will make them of the synagogue of **Satan**, which say they are Jews, and are not, but do lie; behold, I will make them to come and worship before thy feet, and to know that I have loved thee.

Revelation of John 12:9: And the great dragon was cast out, that old serpent, called the Devil, and **Satan**, which deceiveth the whole world: he was cast out into the earth, and his angels were cast out with him.

Revelation of John 20:2: And he laid hold on the dragon, that old serpent, which is the Devil, and **Satan**, and bound him a thousand years,

Revelation of John 20:7: And when the thousand years are expired, **Satan** shall be loosed out of his prison,

Verses about the devil:

Matthew 4:1: Then was Jesus led up of the Spirit into the wilderness to be tempted of the **devil**.

Matthew 4:5: Then the **devil** taketh him up into the holy city, and setteth him on a pinnacle of the temple,

Matthew 4:8: Again, the **devil** taketh him up into an exceeding high mountain, and sheweth him all the kingdoms of the world, and the glory of them;

Matthew 4:11: Then the **devil** leaveth him, and, behold, angels came and ministered unto him.

Matthew 9:32:

As they went out, behold, they brought to him a dumb man possessed with a **devil**.

Matthew 9:33: And when the **devil** was cast out, the dumb spake:

and the multitudes marvelled, saying, It was never so seen in Israel.

Matthew 11:18: For John came neither eating nor drinking, and they say, He hath a **devil**.

Matthew 12:22:

Then was brought unto him one possessed with a **devil**, blind, and dumb: and he healed him, insomuch that the blind and dumb both spake and saw.

Matthew 13:39: The enemy that sowed them is the **devil**; the harvest is the end of the world; and the reapers are the angels.

Matthew 15:22: And, behold, a woman of Canaan came out of the same coasts, and cried unto him, saying, Have mercy on me, O Lord, thou Son of David; my daughter is grievously vexed with a **devil**.

Matthew 17:18: And Jesus rebuked the **devil**; and he departed out of him: and the child was cured from that very hour.

Matthew 25:41: Then shall he say also unto them on the left hand, Depart from me, ye cursed, into everlasting fire, prepared for the **devil** and his angels:

Mark 5:15: And they come to Jesus, and see him that was possessed with the **devil**, and had the legion, sitting, and clothed, and in his right mind: and they were afraid.

Mark 5:16: And they that saw it told them how it befell to him that was possessed with the **devil**, and also concerning the swine.

Mark 5:18: And when he was come into the ship, he that had been possessed with the **devil** prayed him that he might be with him.

Mark 7:26: The woman was a Greek, a Syrophenician by nation; and she besought him that he would cast forth the **devil** out of her daughter.

Mark 7:29: And he said unto her, For this saying go thy way; the **devil** is gone out of thy daughter.

Mark 7:30: And when she was come to her house, she found the **devil** gone out, and her daughter laid upon the bed.

Luke 4:2: Being forty days tempted of the **devil**. And in those days he did eat nothing: and when they were ended, he afterward hungered.

Luke 4:3: And the **devil** said unto him, If thou be the Son of God, command this stone that it be made bread.

Luke 4:5: And the **devil**, taking him up into an high mountain, shewed unto him all the kingdoms of the world in a moment of time.

Luke 4:6: And the **devil** said unto him, All this power will I give thee, and the glory of them: for that is delivered unto me; and to whomsoever I will I give it.

Luke 4:13: And when the **devil** had ended all the temptation, he departed from him for a season.

Luke 4:33:

And in the synagogue there was a man, which had a spirit of an unclean **devil**, and cried out with a loud voice,

Luke 4:35: And Jesus rebuked him, saying, Hold thy peace, and come out of him. And when the **devil** had thrown him in the midst, he came out of him, and hurt him not.

Luke 7:33: For John the Baptist came neither eating bread nor drinking wine; and ye say, He hath a **devil**.

Luke 8:12: Those by the way side are they that hear; then cometh the **devil**, and taketh away the word out of their hearts, lest they should believe and be saved.

Luke 8:29: (For he had commanded the unclean spirit to come out of the man. For oftentimes it had caught him: and he was kept bound with chains and in fetters; and he brake the bands, and was driven of the **devil** into the wilderness.)

Luke 9:42: And as he was yet a coming, the **devil** threw him down, and tare him. And Jesus rebuked the unclean spirit, and healed the child, and delivered him again to his father.

Luke 11:14:

And he was casting out a **devil**, and it was dumb. And it came to pass, when the **devil** was gone out, the dumb spake; and the people wondered.

John 6:70: Jesus answered them, Have not I chosen you twelve, and one of you is a **devil**?

John 7:20: The people answered and said, Thou hast a **devil**: who goeth about to kill thee?

John 8:44: Ye are of your father the **devil**, and the lusts of your father ye will do. He was a murderer from the beginning, and abode not in the truth, because there is no truth in him. When he speaketh a lie, he speaketh of his own: for he is a liar, and the father of it.

John 8:48: Then answered the Jews, and said unto him, Say we not well that thou art a Samaritan, and hast a **devil**?

John 8:49: Jesus answered, I have not a **devil**; but I honour my Father, and ye do dishonour me.

John 8:52: Then said the Jews unto him, Now we know that thou hast a **devil**. Abraham is dead, and the prophets; and thou sayest, If a man keep my saying, he shall never taste of death.

John 10:20: And many of them said, He hath a **devil**, and is mad; why hear ye him?

John 10:21: Others said, These are not the words of him that hath a **devil**. Can a **devil** open the eyes of the blind?

John 13:2: And supper being ended, the **devil** having now put into the heart of Judas Iscariot, Simon's son, to betray him;

Acts 10:38: How God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Ghost

and with power: who went about doing good, and healing all that were oppressed of the **devil**; for God was with him.

Acts 13:10: And said, O full of all subtilty and all mischief, thou child of the **devil**, thou enemy of all righteousness, wilt thou not cease to pervert the right ways of the Lord?

Ephesians 4:27: Neither give place to the **devil**.

Ephesians 6:11: Put on the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to stand against the wiles of the **devil**.

I Timothy 3:6: Not a novice, lest being lifted up with pride he fall into the condemnation of the **devil**.

I Timothy 3:7: Moreover he must have a good report of them which are without; lest he fall into reproach and the snare of the **devil**.

II Timothy 2:26: And that they may recover themselves out of the snare of the **devil**, who are taken captive by him at his will.

Hebrews 2:14: Forasmuch then as the children are partakers of flesh and blood, he also himself likewise took part of the same; that through death he might destroy him that had the power of death, that is, the **devil**;

James 4:7: Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the **devil**, and he will flee from you.

I Peter 5:8: Be sober, be vigilant; because your adversary the **devil**, as a roaring lion, walketh about, seeking whom he may devour:

I John 3:8: He that committeth sin is of the **devil**; for the **devil** sinneth from the beginning. For this purpose the Son of God was manifested, that he might destroy the works of the **devil**.

I John 3:10: In this the children of God are manifest, and the children of the **devil**: whosoever doeth not righteousness is not of God, neither he that loveth not his brother.

Jude 1:9: Yet Michael the archangel, when contending with the **devil** he disputed about the body of Moses, durst not bring against him a railing accusation, but said, The Lord rebuke thee.

Revelation of John 2:10: Fear none of those things which thou shalt suffer: behold, the **devil** shall cast some of you into prison, that ye may be tried; and ye shall have tribulation ten days: be thou faithful unto death, and I will give thee a crown of life.

Revelation of John 12:9: And the great dragon was cast out, that old serpent, called the **Devil**, and Satan, which deceiveth the whole world: he was cast out into the earth, and his angels were cast out with him.

Revelation of John 12:12: Therefore rejoice, ye heavens, and ye that dwell in them. Woe to the inhabitants of the earth and of the sea! for the **devil** is come down unto you, having great wrath, because he knoweth that he hath but a short time.

Revelation of John 20:2: And he laid hold on the dragon, that old serpent, which is the **Devil**, and Satan, and bound him a thousand years,

Revelation of John 20:10: And the **devil** that deceived them was cast into the lake of fire and brimstone, where the beast and the false prophet are, and shall be tormented day and night for ever and ever.
