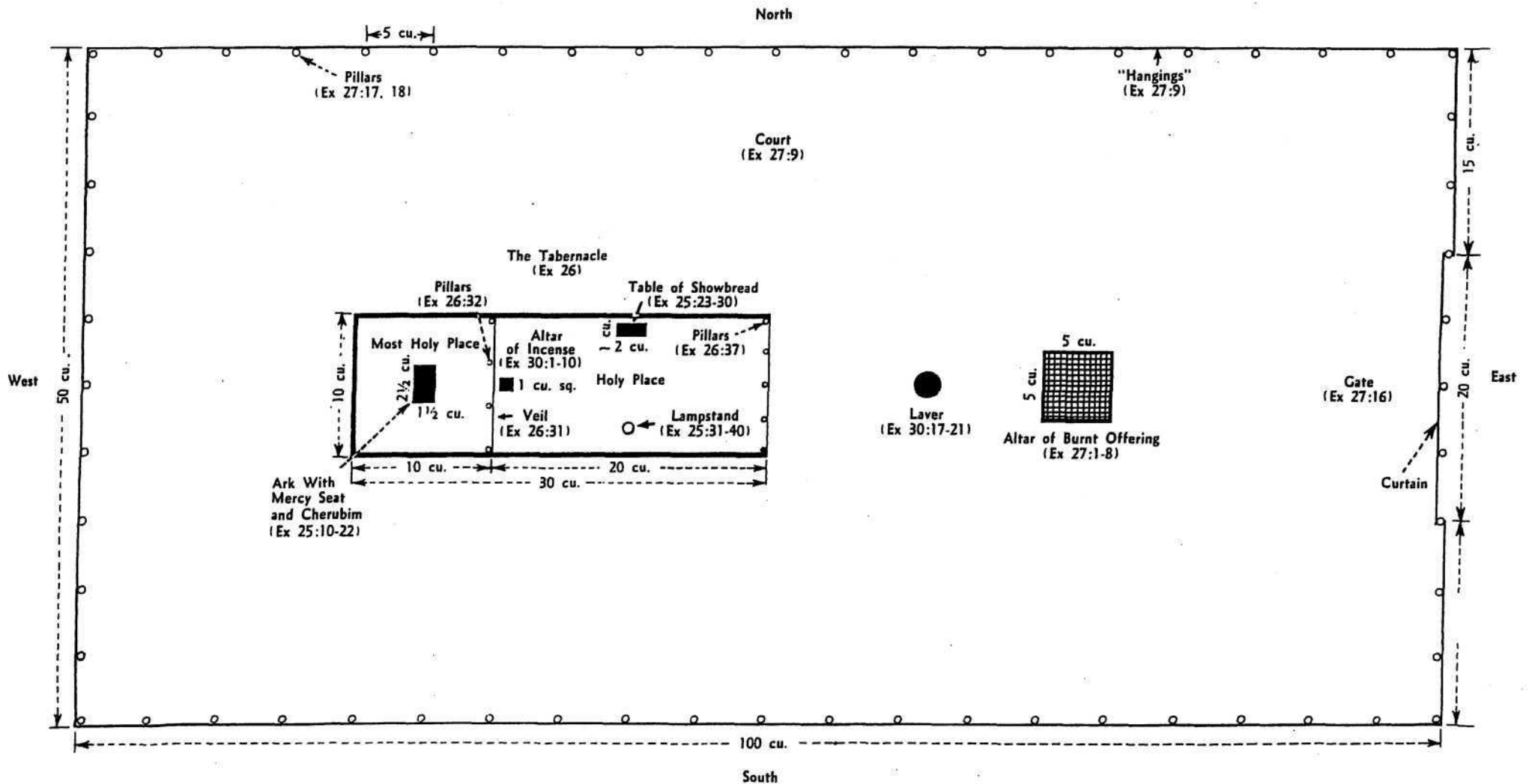

The Brazen Altar

Build an altar of acacia wood, three cubits high; it is to be square, five cubits long and five cubits wide.

Exodus 27:1

The Laver

Make a bronze basin, with its bronze stand, for washing. Place it between the Tent of Meeting and the altar, and put water in it.

Exodus 30:18

The Golden Table

Make a table of acacia wood - two cubits long, a cubit wide and a cubit and a half high. Overlay it with pure gold and make a gold molding around it. Also make around it a rim a handbreadth wide and put a gold molding on the rim.

Exodus 25:23-25

The Altar of Incense

Make an altar of acacia wood for square, a cubit long and a cubit wide, and two cubits high - its horns of one piece with it. Overlay the top and all the sides and the horns with pure gold, and make a gold molding around it.

Exodus 30:1-3

Golden Candlestick

Make a lampstand of pure gold and hammer it out, base and shaft; its flower-like cups, buds and blossoms shall be of one piece with it. Six branches are to extend from the sides of the lamp stand - three on one side and three on the other.

Exodus 25:31-32

The Ark of the Covenant

He took the Testimony and placed it in the ark, attached the poles to the ark and put the atonement cover over it. Then he brought the ark into the tabernacle and hung the shielding curtain and shielded the ark of the Testimony, as the Lord commanded him.

Exodus 40:20-21

For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God, and are justified freely by his grace through the redemption that came by Christ Jesus. God presented him as a sacrifice of atonement, though faith in his blood.

... But you were washed, you were sanctified, you were justified in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ and by the Spirit of our God.

Then Jesus declared, "I am the bread of life. He who comes to me will never go hungry, and he who believes in me will never be thirsty.

When Jesus spoke again to the people, he said, "I am the light of the world. Whoever follows me will never walk in darkness, but will have the light of life."

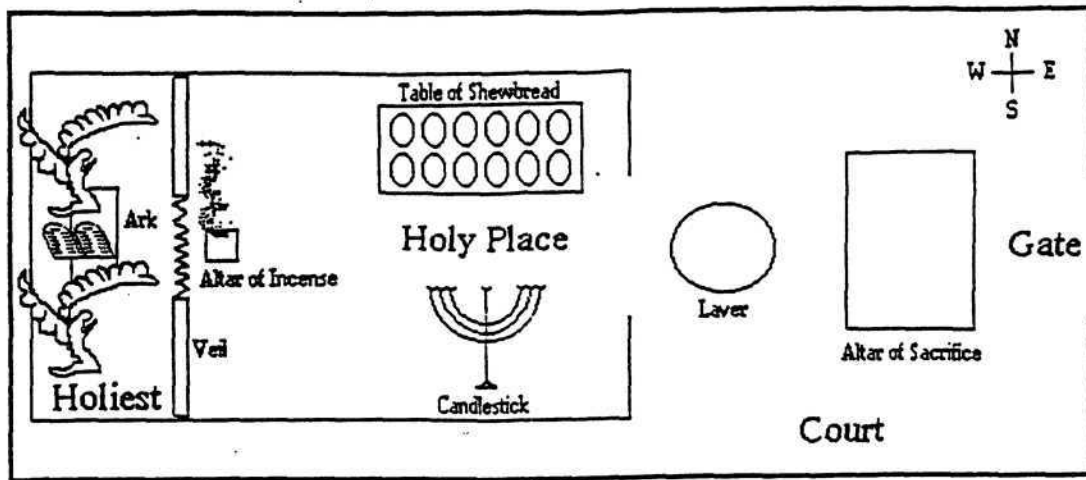
John 8:12

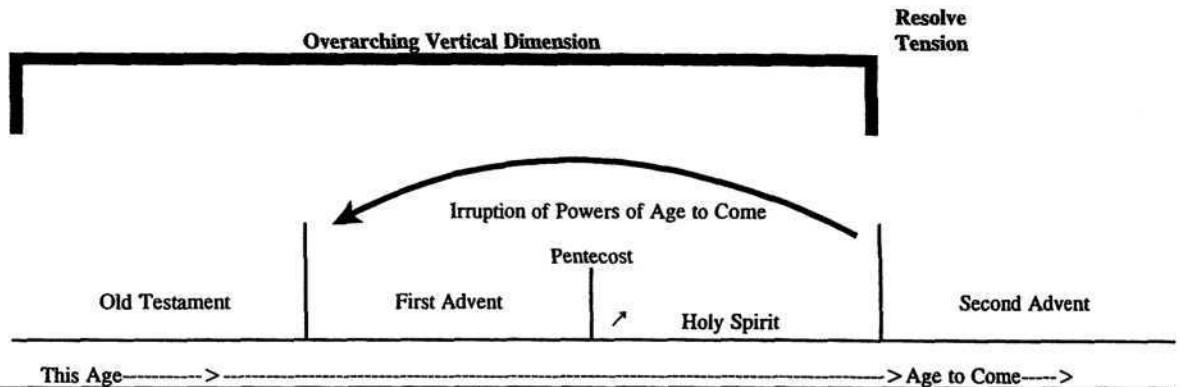


Sanctuary Prayer

Sanctuary	Represents	Prayer
Gate of the court	Praise - "Enter into His gates with thanksgiving, and into His courts with praise." Psalm 100:4	Give Praise and Thanks to God.
Altar of Sacrifice (the Cross)	Confession (Justification) - "If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins . . ." 1 John 1:9	Confession of sins.
Laver	Washing at the Laver - "... and to cleanse us of all unrighteousness." 1 John 1:9	Seek the recollection of sins from the Holy Spirit and washing or cleansing from the Word.
7-Branched Candlestick— Illuminates the whole sanctuary	The Holy Spirit - "The spirit of man is the candle of the Lord, searching all the inward parts of the belly." Prov. 20:27	Ask for the 7-fold aspect of the Holy Spirit: wisdom, understanding, counsel, might/power, knowledge, fear of the Lord, judgment/discernment Isaiah 11:2-4
The Table of Shewbread (Bread of the Presence)	Jesus - The Table of Shewbread is considered the throne of Christ. He is the Bread of Life and His presence is always before God. "I am the Living Bread which came down from heaven: if any man eat of this Bread, he shall live for ever." John 6:51	Seek knowledge and communion with Jesus—the Bread of Life. Spend time here talking with Jesus.
Veil	The Grace of Christ - "Having . . . boldness to enter into the holiest . . . through the veil, that is to say, His flesh." Heb. 10:19-20	Remember and be thankful for the Grace of Christ that covers us.
Altar of Incense	Intercession - "Let my prayer be set forth before Thee as incense." Ps. 141:2	Intercessory prayer
Ark of the Covenant - "By the ark of the testimony, before the mercy seat . . . where I will meet with thee." Ex. 30:6	The Throne of God - "Let us therefore come boldly unto the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy, and find grace to help in time of need." Heb. 4:16	Communion with God - "Oh that I knew where I might find Him! That I might come even to His seat!" Job 23:3
